The Connecticut Light and Power Company (CL&P) is dedicated to providing reliable electricity and superior customer service

CL&P has developed a five-year System Resiliency Program to upgrade and strengthen its infrastructure across the state to reduce the possibility of service interruptions, especially during severe weather. This program includes structural hardening which entails replacing existing transmission structures, structure cross arms and/or structure hardware.

The purpose of this letter is to notify you that CL&P will soon be doing some or all of the work mentioned above on or near your property within CL&P's existing right-of-way. The work is not expected to interrupt electric service to homes or businesses.

Activities that you may see associated with this work may include removing brush and tall vegetation, mowing, making improvements to existing access roads, installing timber mats, building crane pads to support heavy equipment, and restoring the disturbed area.

If work is going to be taking place directly on your property you will be contacted by a CL&P representative to discuss the construction activities.
