Job Summary:

Under the direction of the Sewer and Collections Supervisor, performs semi-skilled manual work assisting in the maintenance and operations at a complex class IV wastewater treatment plant and collections system. Assists in and performs daily operation and maintenance in a wide variety of aspects of proper wastewater treatment.

Essential Job Functions:(These examples are intended only as illustrations of various types of work performed. The examples of work performed are neither restricted to nor all-encompassing of the duties to be performed under this job title.)

- Must be highly motivated and work well within a team environment
- Demonstrated knowledge and ability working safely and responsibly with use of proper personal protective equipment. Ensures working environment is free of debris and hazards.
- Establish and maintain effective working relationships with peers, supervisors, contractors, and vendors.
- Understand and follow oral and written instructions.
- Operate Septage Receiving Station assuring septage haulers properly discharge and receive ticket, and provide customer service to haulers.
- Manual labor, shoveling and plowing, mowing grass, housekeeping, and general building maintenance.
- Operate filter presses and related polymer equipment, portable generators, and pumps.
- Participates in On-Call rotation providing emergency response to plant and pump stations, as well as Call before you dig (CBYD) mark-outs. Must be able to respond within 20 minutes of the call.
- Laboratory duties in absence of Process Control.
- Shipping and receiving.
- Cleaning, hosing, and preventative maintenance of equipment.
- Performs related work as assigned.

Education, Training and Experience:

- Graduation from high school or certification of having passed the General Educational Development (GED) certification examination.

Special Requirements:

- Must obtain within 24 months of hire a CT DEEP Class 1 wastewater treatment operator certification and maintain certification throughout employment.
