NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids for the East Street Roadway and Streetscape Improvements will be received by the Finance Department, 10 Main Street, Town Hall, New Milford, CT 06776 until 3:00 p.m., Thursday, May 20, 2010, at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read aloud.

Work includes approximately 2000 SF of concrete sidewalk and related streetscape improvements on East Street.

Bid documents will be available for pickup between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding holidays at the Finance Department, 10 Main Street, Town Hall, New Milford, CT 06776, upon payment of non-refundable fee of \$50.00 per set. Partial sets will not be distributed. Proposals must be submitted on the forms provided and in a sealed envelope, plainly marked with the appropriate title.

Contract plans and documents will be made available on the Department's web site, www.newmilford.org however, to be considered a responsive bidder the contractor shall have obtained at least one complete set of paper plans and specifications from the Town of New Milford Purchasing Department. The Bid will not be awarded to a Bidder unless a record for the purchase exists in the office of the owner, in the same name that appears on the bid documents.

Bid security payable to the Town of New Milford in the form of a bid bond only is required for 5% of the base bid proposal, issued by an acceptable surety on AIA Document A310 or comparable legal bond form, and must accompany each bid and must be listed on the most recent IRS Circular 570.

Attention to bidders is directed to certain requirements of this contract which require payment of the State of Connecticut Prevailing Wage Rates and compliance with certain local and state requirements. Please refer to the Special Provisions section of the specifications for more details on these requirements. This is a State of Connecticut funded project.

The successful bidder must post a 100% Performance Bond and a 100% Labor & Materials Bond on notice of contract award in the form of an AIA Document A311 or comparable legal bond form. The cost of these bonds must be included in the bid price.


Contractors must carry minimum insurance coverage limits, as indicated in the bid specifications. A certificate of insurance must accompany all bids.

The Town of New Milford and our grant consultant, L. Wagner and Associates will be holding a non-mandatory pre-bid meeting in the E. Paul Martin Room, 10 Main Street, Town Hall, New Milford, CT 06776 from 12-1 pm, Thursday May 6, 2010.

Any bidder found by the Purchasing Authority to be delinquent in the payment of taxes and/or sewer use charge due to the Town of New Milford, for either personal or real property, shall abide by the regulations as set forth in the Purchase Ordinance (as amended 08.09.93) Sec. 2.92 Bids. Copies of which may be obtained at the Finance Office, Town Hall.

The Town of New Milford reserves the right to accept or reject any and all bids or any part thereof; to waive any informalities, or to accept any bid deemed to be in the best interest of the Town of New Milford.

All bids will be considered valid for a period of forty-five (45) days.
