UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

- ☠ Toxic or Hazardous Waste (includes oil-based paint)
- ☠ Any Type of Oil Tank
- ☠ Propane Tanks
- ☠ NICAD and Mercury Batteries

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE RECYCLABLE

NEWSPAPERS

- Includes all flyers that come with the paper-NO packing paper

MAGAZINES

- All glossy magazines & catalogs, staples ok.

OFFICE PAPER

- Un-shredded Office & Computer Paper
- Separated (white & color)
- Shredded paper is Household garbage

FOOD CONTAINERS

These Food Groups May be Mixed Together ("Co-mingled")

Glass-Food Only

- All sizes & colors
- Rinsed clean
- Lids removed

Plastic-Food Only

- Containers embossed with the number 1 or 2 on the bottom only
- Rinsed clean
- Oil containers go with Household Garbage

Aluminum & Tin

- Food cans & foil & food containers
- Rinsed clean

CARDBOARD

- Corrugated (double-wall cell type) boxes only
- No cereal or soda type boxes

MISCELLANEOUS

- Household Batteries may be disposed of with household garbage.
- NOT nickel cadmium or mercury.**

METAL-\$1.00

Minimum Charge

Scrap aluminum, steel, copper, pipes, toaster oven, pots & pans, fax machines, modems, keyboards, metal chairs (w/fabric)etc.

PAINT

- Empty & completely dried latex (water based) or alkyd (oil based) paint cans

CLOTHING

- Salvation Army bin on premises.

The Center encourages residents to help themselves, but assistance is always available.

FREE TABLE

The Center has a "free table" on which residents may remove items for free. There is a minimum fee of \$1.00 for items left on the free table. Other charges may apply at the discretion of Center personnel. There are also "mandatory bulky waste fees." The Center encourages the use of this table but requires browsers to park outside the facility in a manner that doesn't interfere with the Ambulance Barn entrance or exit.

SMALL BUSINESS USE

(New Milford Businesses Only):

A small business is defined as one that has not more than 2 principals and 10 employees. Small businesses are required to pay the "mandatory bulky waste fees", the "fees for specific items" and \$.10/lb for recyclables. There is also a scrap metal minimum charge of \$10.00.
