

Title: ARTICLE II FOOD VENDING TRUCKS

Section 15-16 Purpose:

The purpose of this ordinance is to permit licensed, mobile, non-permanent food vending trucks or vehicles (Vendor) to operate on private property at which commercial entities operate so as to allow foodstuffs to be conveniently available to patrons while on premises to encourage patronage of New Milford stores and enterprises.

Section 15-17 License requirements and restrictions:

(a) No person, firm, entity, organization or company (Person) shall be permitted to operate a food vending truck or vehicle (Food Truck) unless the Vendor shall first have applied for and obtained a vending license from the Mayor's office and passed an inspection conducted by the New Milford Health Director or his or her authorized designee. Such inspections shall be required in no greater than three (3) month intervals and at such other times as the Health Director shall require. The permit fee shall be \$160.00 per month or such other amount as the Town Council may from time-to-time determine.

(b) Food Truck vending may be permitted only on commercial premises where a business (Operator) on the same premises is its host and such host is actively and lawfully engaged in a commercial enterprise on private property for which the Operator has a lawful possessory interest, and further providing the Operator and property landlord have furnished written permission to the Vendor. Food Truck vending shall not be permitted within 250' of the entrance to a permanent, immobile restaurant or any other type of fixed food service operation serving prepared food either on or off the same premises. Food Truck Vending is absolutely prohibited in residential zones. Tables and chairs shall not be permitted. The license shall be revocable at will.

(c) No more than two Food Trucks may be permitted on each eligible property. Food Truck operation shall be limited to the same hours of operation as the host business. In addition to the separation distance from fixed, food service facilities, Vendor shall locate the Food Truck such that it does not impair sight lines or ingress and egress, and the Operator and Vendor shall comply with all police orders and requests as to emplacement of the Vendor in relation to public
