WHEREAS, the year 2023 marks the 63rd annual National Public Works Week sponsored by the American Public Works Association/ Canadian Public Works Association be it now,

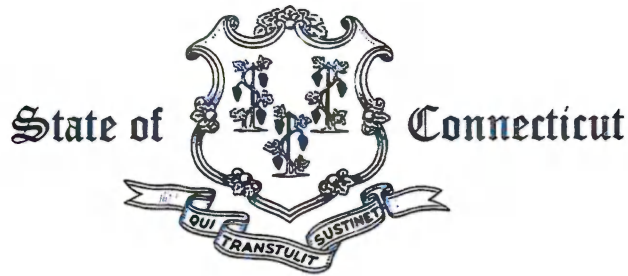
